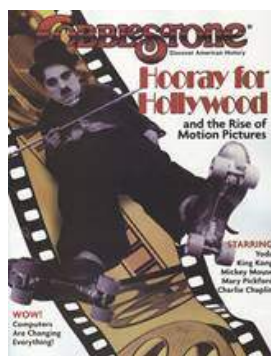
I hope you will look it up and consider acquiring it for your media center collection.
