# K-1 Media Literacy - Images and Emotions

# Essential Question: How does the media I see and hear impact me?

# Lesson Focus and Objective(s)

The focus of this lesson will be to introduce K/1 students to the idea that media images can trigger our emotions.

Objectives (student "I can ..." statements):

- I can tell you how an image makes me feel.
- I understand that other people have different emotions about an image.

## **Resources and Materials**

Smart Board with images for students to view. Images can be book covers or advertising images that might evoke strong emotions.

## **Environment**

The library session is 30 minutes long. This includes a 15 minute book checkout period and a 15 minute lesson. Lesson will be conducted in front of the SmartBoard with students sitting on the carpet with partners.

## Vocabulary

Emotions Media Images

## **Assessment Plan**

Students will use thumbs up, sideways, or down to show their understanding of the lesson.

## **Lesson Introduction 1-2 minutes**

Ask students how they are feeling today and express how you are feeling. Ask students about a time when they felt happy or sad and what made them feel that way.

### Lesson Core 10-12 minutes

**Say**: Wow! You are all experts in knowing how you feel! Did you know that pictures can make us feel different emotions? Let's look at a few pictures.

(show one picture and model with a think aloud about how the picture makes you feel.)

**Say**: OK your turn. I am going to show you a picture: a media image. When you see the image, stop and think about how it makes you feel. Give me a thumbs up when you have a word that describes how you feel.

(30-60 second wait time) At this point, have students turn and talk to a neighbor. Have them express the emotion they felt when they saw the image.

**Say**: Wow! I am hearing a lot of emotions being express. I heard some people say (insert emotion words). AND I just noticed something. Not everyone felt the exact same way about some of the media images. Would anyone like to share their word and why they chose that word?

(Note: If time allows, show another picture)

# Lesson Conclusión 1-2 minutes

**Say:** You are all amazing observers of your own emotions and media images. Before we go, I have a question. If I showed you another picture do you think you could name the emotion you feel when you look at it? Yes= thumbs up, No= thumbs down, maybe = thumbs sideways.

Thank you for sharing that with me. I can't wait do look at more media images with you next time.
